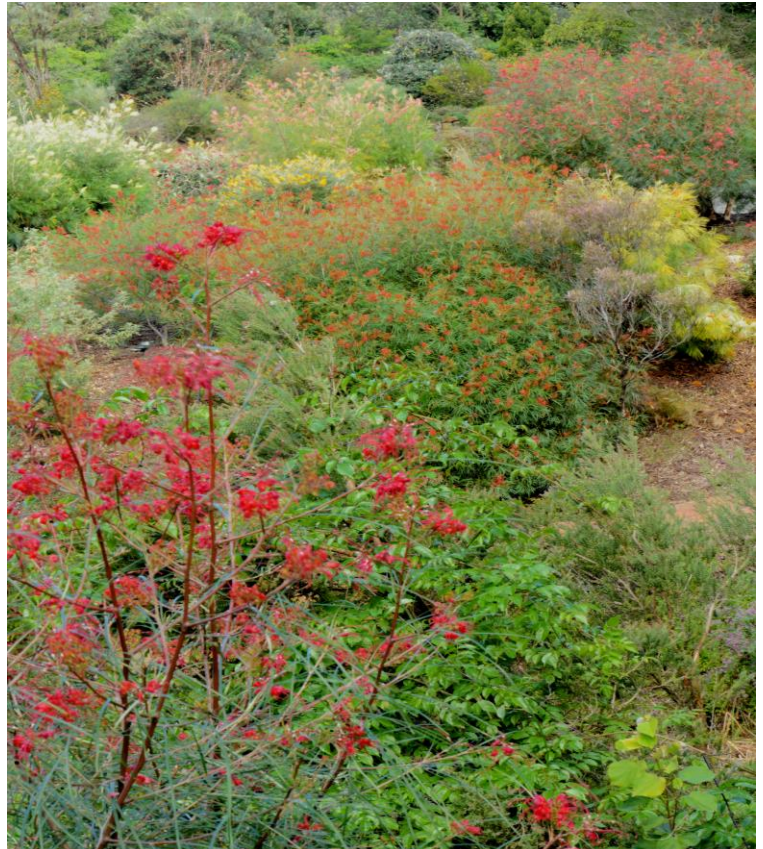

**LOCATION:** Nestled at the foot of the Illawarra Escarpment near the historic township of Bulli, the park is at the rear of Bulli Showground, Princes Highway Bulli. A short 10 minute walk from Bulli Station.

**COST:** \$5.00 adults and children free.
